



- Rule 11.K It is a fault if a player contacts the net post while the ball is in play.
- Rule 11.K.1 A ball contacting the net, the net cable, or rope between the net posts remains in play.
- Rule 11.L.2 If the ball travels between the net and the net post, it is a fault against the striking player.
- Rule 11.M. and 11.M.1 and 11.M.2

 A player may return the ball around the outside of the net post.
- Rule 11.M.1. The ball does not need to travel back over the net.



Rule 11.M.2. There is no restriction on the height of the return, meaning a player may return the ball around the net post below the height of the net.
